

This policy provides a framework for the use of facilities at Douglas College by internal and external users. Douglas College is a major community centre for academic and occupational, athletic, social and cultural activities. To further this role, the College permits the use of its facilities by external organizations and community groups.

This policy applies to all members of the College Community.

Includes all employees, students, users, contractors, suppliers, guests and any other person participating in any College-related activity or attending an event on College premises.



1. All Douglas College space allocation is the responsibility of the Manager, Facilities Services at each campus. No accommodation will be made for groups or individuals that promote or encourage discrimination on the basis of sex, race, colour, ancestry, place of origin, political belief, religion, marital status, family status, physical or mental disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression or age (see *Human Rights Policy*).
