- 3. Demonstrate initiative and innovation in clinical practice settings as evidenced by outstanding clinical practice appraisals from their clinical instructors
- 4. Demonstrate exemplary standards of ethical and professional caring in their practice as evidenced from their clinical practice appraisals
- 5. Submit a 500 word paper outlining how they have implemented PSR concepts in their practice as a student and/or how their vision of how PSR principles will influence their future practice in assisting individuals experiencing mental health issues on their road to recovery and selfdetermination
- 6. Be a Canadian citizen, landed immigrant or convention refugee
