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A. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish and communicate the designation of Honorary Fellow to distinguish individuals of such standing so that they may inspire graduates and reflect the Values of the College in the wider community.

B. This policy applies to employees, students and Board members, and any other person who is contractually obligated to comply with College policy. The purpose of this policy includes Douglas College alumni.

Honorary Fellow An individual recognized by Douglas College for outstanding achievement or distinguished service on a community, provincial, national or international scale and who accepts the College's offer of an honorific title intended to signal a sharing of values and mutual regard between the College and the individual so recognized.
